What is MWOA?

- ⊕ Men and Women of Action (MWOA) provide an opportunity for men and women to volunteer their skills in building project assignments and disaster relief. Even though our main emphasis is construction teams, we also work with medical, humanitarian and Christmas teams.

What is a MWOA Construction Trip?

- ⊕ These trips involve men and women from around the world who help build churches, clinics, schools, training centers, orphanages and other facilities. Trips usually last 10 to 14 days.
- ⊕ MWOA volunteers pay their own travel expenses and volunteer their labor.
- ⊕ MWOA is not a sightseeing trip. Our emphasis is the project.
- ⊕ Although many MWOA projects are on foreign lands, many are located in the USA.
- ⊕ Volunteers are always needed during times of disasters.

What are the Trip's Objectives?

- ⊕ To meet a specific need on the mission field here and abroad.
- ⊕ To impact the lives of those who participate in the project and those who helped you go.

How can I raise funds to go on a trip?

- ⊕ Send out personal letters to friends, family and business acquaintances.
- ⊕ COMMIT yourself to the trip. Don't say if I raise enough money, I am going on this trip.
- ⊕ People seem to help someone who had already made the commitment to go.
- ⊕ Talk about your trip. You never know who is listening.
- ⊕ Talk to your church or Bible Study group.

What is the first thing I need to do to participate in a project?

- ⊕ Make a commitment - send in your volunteer application form and deposit.
- ⊕ This will secure you a place on the team.
